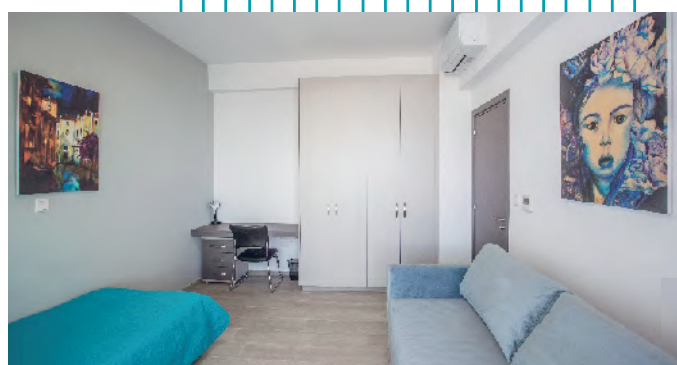

### BOOKS

All recommended school books to be followed during the academic year shall be supplied to the student. A detailed list will be supplied upon registration and students will receive the books on the first day of attending lessons.

### SCHOOL UNIFORM

The students will need Xenion School Uniform during the academic year.

### TRANSPORTATION

#### TRANSPORT TO AND FROM THE AIRPORT

Transport will be provided to and from the airport on the first arrival of the student only.

#### TRANSPORT TO AND FROM THE SCHOOL

Transport will be provided to and from the school premises for morning and, if necessary, for afternoon lessons.

#### SCHOOL EXCURSIONS WITHIN CYPRUS

In each academic year there is a number of educational outings to museums and other historical places of interest. Full board fees cover all such trips.

### EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

### INDIVIDUAL LESSONS

Private tuition is provided, if necessary, through Xenion Institute.

### EXTERNAL EXAMINATIONS

During the course the students will have to sit external examinations. The students must pay an examination fee to the British Examining Board. This fee depends on the subject the student will be examined in.

### ENTRANCE EXAMS

The students need to do Entrance Exams which can be taken here at school or online. They can all be taken on a single day, or on separate days. The Entrance Examination cost is €100.

### ADD-ON CLUBS

Add-on clubs the student may wish to attend.

### VISA DEPOSIT

There is a refundable additional cost of €550-€850 which is required by the immigration authorities to be deposited for each student. This amount is returned to the student upon completion of the course and departure from the country. It is also fully refundable if the student's visa application is not successful.
