Covid-19 Response Strategy

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Which are your Covid procedures on arrival at the centre?
Students will be asked to present their negative test result upon arrival. We will measure the temperature of each student upon arrival and all premises will be fully disinfected.
2. Do you have a place in your premises specially designated for quarantine in case there are students affected by Covid-19?
Yes, we have a special room for students, or any persons affected by Covid-19. Students will stay within the same group during their stay, and they will not be mixed up with other groups in the accommodation residence.
3. In case one of the students or group leaders will be infected with Covid-19 how are you going to manage this? Will the whole group have to be placed in quarantine or just the affected person?
The affected person will be definitely singled out, the rest will follow the programme as normal except of activities that could be highly contagious to other people eg. luna park, waterpark, all close contacts will make a test and repeat after 3 days if needed.

Students leave the airport, and they receive an SMS within 3 hours with the result.
4. Will you have staff that will look after to students that will be placed under quarantine if the group has to leave?
Yes.
5. If the whole group is infected with Covid-19 will you provide accommodation for them where to spend it?
Yes.
6. In case your/our Government will impose travel restrictions (no flights, mandatory quarantine, mandatory vaccination, etc) which is your Covid-19 refund policy?
Any cancellations due to Covid-19 related reasons will be fully refunded upon written proof.
7. Are you in touch with a medical centre that can provide Covid-19 test for students before they go back home?

Yes, the medical centre which provides the test is easily accessible, the procedure is fast. The PCR test will be made 3 days prior to departure and will be paid by each person tested.

8. If one of our students is positive to Covid-19 and is really sick but does not need to be hospitalized will your staff be ready to look after him/her?

Yes of course, we have permanent staff in our Boarding House and can take care of the student in that case and in all cases.
