

EXTERNAL EXAMS GUIDE

- 1 | Complete your identification (name, surname) as it appears on your ID/Passport (It should be the same as the one you completed on your application form).
- 2 | The application will be given well in advance so that you have time to fill it in follow the instructions and guidelines from your teachers. Keep to the deadlines late entries will be charged by the examination board you are entering.
- **3** Write in capital letters so that it can be read clearly (Changing name/surname or date of birth can result to additional charges from the examination board you are entering).
- **4** Dress appropriately and sensibly (hood, caps, hats are also not permitted).
- **5** You cannot borrow or lend equipment (ruler, calculator, pencil, rubber) during an exam. It is your responsibility to know what you are entitled and bring it to an exam.
- **6** During the examination you must follow the regulations of the relevant examination board.
- **7** | See below and familiarize yourselves with the following notices.
- **8** | Bring your ID/Passport with you to each exam. Your statement of entry is not needed (Unless you are an external candidate).
- **9** Arrive 30min before the start time of your exam-you will be given instructions approximately 20min before the start and you will be asked to enter the exam room around 15min before.
- **10** So not have any unauthorized material in your possession such as electronic devices, smart watches and mobile phones.
- **11** Do not attempt to communicate with or disturb any of the candidates once you have entered the exam room.
- **12** Leave any used and unused material in the exam room.
- **13** Follow the instructions of the invigilator in charge.
- **14** Breaking any of these rules will result in your DISQUALIFICATION!
- 15 You must not be involved in any unfair or dishonest practice before during or after an exam.
- **16** DO NOT sit an exam in the name of another candidate.
- **17** If you are in doubt speak to your invigilator.

Notice to Candidates:

YOU MUST

- . be on time for any exams and any periods of Full Centre Supervision

- . talk to, attempt to communicate with, or disturb other candidates once you have entered the exam room
