ENTRANCE EXAM VIA VIDEO CALL PROCEDURE

General Information

- The date and the time of the exam is arranged in prior with the International Office.
- Entrance exams consist of:
 - 1. English exam (2 hours)
 - 2. Mathematics exam (2 hours)
 - 3. Non-verbal reasoning test (15 minutes)
- Exams can be taken on a single day or on separate days. If the exams are taken on a single day, the student takes a 20-minute break between each exam.
- The use of mobile phone, computer or another device or dictionary is not allowed.
- The student should be alone in the room.

Steps

- 1. Video Call, introduction & Instructions. The examiner sends the exam paper to the student, the student prints of the exam paper.
- 2. The exam starts. The camera should be placed on the paper and the student.
- 3. When the exam finishes, the student scans or photographs the paper and sends it immediately to the examiner.
- **4.** The procedure is completed. The exam will be forwarded to teachers for correction and marking.
- 5. Announcement of the result within 5 working days. The International Office sends the corrected paper to the student.



Sample Schedule (CY Time)

- **08:00** Video call, introduction & instructions. The examiner sends the exam paper to the student. The student prints the exam.
- **08:15** English exam
- 10:15 End of the exam. The student scans or photographs the paper and sends it immediately to the examiner.
- **10:20** Break
- 10:40 The examiner sends the exam paper to the student. The student prints the exam.
- 10:50 Mathematics exam
- 12:50 End of the exam. The student scans or photographs the paper and sends it immediately to the examiner.
- **12:55** Break
- 13:15 The examiner sends the exam paper to the student. The student prints the exam.
- 13:25 Non-verbal reasoning test
- 13:40 End of the exam. The student scans or photographs the paper and sends it immediately to the examiner.
- 13:45 Questions. End of video call.
