## XENION

 Junior School- Xenion Junior School was established and functions under the supervision of the Ministry of Education and Culture and in accordance with relevant educational statutes.
- The school offers to students in the Famagusta area and to students from abroad, an alternative to state preschool and primary education.
- Students complete a Preschool programme.
- Students complete a six-year, fully-comprehensive Primary course and are enrolled provided that they satisfy the entrance requirements.
- The school was set up in order to satisfy the needs of students and fulfill parents' expectations of a high-quality education, for the modern world.
- The Junior School is based upon the same philosophy which has allowed our senior school to achieve, year after year, results which are truly world-class. The founding motto of Xenion Education "Knowledge is Freedom and Power" informs everything we do.
- We aim to promote, through quality education, the values and characteristics that should distinguish the new European citizen, able to take their place anywhere in the world but retaining their national identity.



## SCHOOL AIMS

## 园国 cuniculum

- The main curriculum of Xenion Junior School is a modified one which includes the best of both the Cypriot National Curriculum and British Key Stages 1 and 2. A sensible balance of the two ensures that our Cypriot students cover the National curriculum every bit as fully as their peers in state schools. In addition, Xenion Junior School offers a broader education, including fluency in English and other languages, with a wider, more European character that meets the needs of our international students. A Preparation Course is offered to international students who speak neither Greek nor English, in order to prepare them for their studies.

Students at Xenion Junior School follow a continuous programme in the following subjects:

## TEACHING METHODS

Learning and teaching at Xenion Junior School are rooted in experiential learning. Students are encouraged to experiment through carefully monitored play and independent discovery and all intelligences, including kinaesthetic, spatial and emotional, are developed.
b There is a hands-on approach to all lessons which helps the students to become confident learners, less likely to rely on 'spoon-feeding' by the teacher.

- Teaching at this school is firmly child-centered and we take advantage of every new and exciting pedagogical method, while always retaining foundations rooted in approaches which have withstood the test of time: we blend the best of the new with the wisdom of previous generations.

- Linguistic improvement is a major aim of our curriculum and is developed every day in both oral and written work.
> We also focus on the improvement of mathematical skills, knowledge and understanding; developing this through practical work, mental maths and more formal, written exercises.
- All aspects of the curriculum are approached with equal care and attention to children's needs, allowing each pupil to express themselves creatively, intellectually and emotionally while developing their talents across the board.

Limited class sizes ensure that each child is given the attention they need to do well and student assessment is formative; designed to support and encourage improvement rather than merely generate grades at the end of the school year.

- Children are not only grouped by age; we also take into account individual abilities, so that our flexible and responsive teaching can enable every child to fulfill their potential.

- One of the most exciting innovations in modern teaching has been the increasing use of computer technology across all areas of the curriculum. This has, in many ways, revolutionised teaching methods. Xenion Junior School has embraced new technology because we know that if we seek to create $21^{\text {st }}$ century citizens, we must have a $21^{\text {st }}$ century school.
- Every classroom at Xenion Junior School has an Interactive Whiteboard (IWB) and projector as well as tablets for the students, enabling the use of an extensive library of e-books, interactive learning materials, educational games and puzzles as well as on-line resources. The IWB also allows Xenion students access to 'Gnositechnia', an interactive one-to-one learning programme based on Ministry of Education materials.
- The most exciting technological innovation is Robotics: the process of creating computer controlled machines in order to carry out a particular task. Robotics is the perfect combination of creativity, design and practical making skills.
- Robotics teaches not only Technology and Computer Science but encourages critical thinking, planning, logic and problem-solving and, because the materials are designed to be used in pairs or small groups, the childrens' ability to communicate, co-operate and delegate is extensively developed.
- Technology is also an essential part of our communication process.



## 3 <br> DISCIPLINE

- At Xenion Junior School we believe that children must be helped to develop self-discipline and respect for themselves and for the people and places around them. This is a major theme in our HPSE syllabus and is reinforced in every aspect of our daily teaching. Lack of discipline and poor conduct affect students' progress and are not acceptable at our school.
- Our rules are simple. They are designed to create conditions which allow everybody to learn and teach in a civilised environment and we help children to understand that these rules must be followed. In addition, we operate a Merit and Penalty points system, which encourages and acknowledges achievement and good conduct but also serves, if necessary, to impose sanctions on those few students who do not behave as they should.
- Our policy is to concentrate on encouraging positive behaviour and to create an ethos in which bad behaviour does not occur. However, if punishment is appropriate, parents will be fully informed.

- We celebrate all major national and international celebrations, festivals and events within the timetable. Groups of students are encouraged to work together to create presentations on a wide range of subjects.
- We take part in a variety of national and international events and competitions organised by both the Ministry of Education and european educational organisations and a variety of educational school trips is arranged each year.



## Hind FIELD TRIPS \& EXCURSIONS

- The school organises termly excursions for which a charge is made. The cost includes entrance fees, lunch and coach transportation. Usually all children and staff are involved in the excursion, making it a wonderful experience.
- Individual teachers organise local field trips which enhance the curriculum by giving children hands on experiences. These trips are usually within the local area and are usually free of charge or subsidised by the School or the Parents' Association. Parental permission will not be asked for field trip excursions as they are part of the school curriculum. More details are added on the monthly agendas.



## PREMISES

- The Junior School is accommodated within its own wing of the Xenion Education Block A. It has its own access and space for parents to drop children off at school and pick them up in the afternoon. The Junior School has its own yard for break-times and students are supervised at all times.
- The Preschool is located in Block C, close to the Junior School entrance.
- All classes are equipped with air-conditioning, Interactive White Boards and internet access and they look directly onto the yard, which is closed off from the nearby road with a gate which is locked during school hours.
- The Junior School has access to all the school's facilities and students at the Junior school quickly become familiar with their wider surroundings, enabling those who wish to continue their education with us to make a smooth transition to the High School at a later date. Xenion Junior offers safe and secure surroundings to all its pupils. There is also a comfortable Reception area where parents can meet with teachers to discuss their child's progress.
- The safety of our students is paramount. Xenion Junior School has a Safeguarding Policy to ensure every child is safe and protected from harm. The full policy is available on the School website. To this end, there are set times and places for parents picking up or dropping off children. If a parent is going to be late or early for any reason they should contact the School so that we can make appropriate arrangements. Under normal circumstances, no-one is allowed to enter the school without an appointment and all visitors must report to the school receptionist.

- The Committee of the Parents" Association is elected during the first meeting of the school year and its term of office is one year. All parents are automatically members of the association. The elected committee meets once a month unless there is a need for an additional meeting.
- The Association aims to give the school practical help in its work and to serve as a bridge of communication between school and parents. It contributes to the smooth running of the school in a number of ways and offers a lot to the students.
- The fee for the parents' association is per family and covers insurance, parties, presents, awards and some subsidies towards school excursions, performances, events, field trips and other school based activities. All subscriptions are fully utilized for the benefit of Xenion Junior School students within the school year.



##  <br> FUN CLUB

- As well as term-time provision, we also have Xenion Summer Fun Club, which provides a programme packed with supervised activities. This is a well established service which is very popular among parents and children.

Dhildren between ages of 4 to 12 can be enrolled. They are grouped in small teams according to their age and are constantly supervised by experienced teachers. The programme runs weekly Monday - Friday from 7:30-14:00 with breakfast and snacks. Xenion Summer Fun Club runs from the end of June to the end of August.


## 123 RECISTRATON \& LEVELS

All students interested in joining Xenion Junior School or Xenion High School are assessed in Maths, English and Greek (if applicable) according to the class and year group they are interested in joining. Meetings with parents and students with members of the Management are also planned prior to registering. Parents of students who successfully pass the exams and wish to register their child, need to bring with them all the necessary documentation as follows:

1. A copy of the child's Birth Certificate
2. A copy of the child's ID card (if they have one)
3. The child's most recent school progress report (if available)
4. Any recent evaluation(s) regarding medical issues or learning difficulties (If applicable)
5. A passport photograph
6. Photocopies of passports or ID cards for both parents/guardians
7. Vaccinations Coverage Certificate signed by a Paediatrician (this document is given to you on the day of registration) and a photocopy of child's medical booklet
8. For overseas applicants, we require proof of a permanent home address in Cyprus. Two of the following original documents must be produced; Driving Licence/Council Tax Receipt/Utility Bill, e.g. water or electricity bill

Please note that Xenion Education has an electronic registration system and the registration procedure is conducted online, using computers which are available in the school lobby. Completion of the registration procedure needs to be carried out by one of the two parents or guardians. Reception staff is available to assist with this procedure.
