A Xenion delegation of 8 students will attend the MEDIMUN conference at the University of Nicosia later this year.

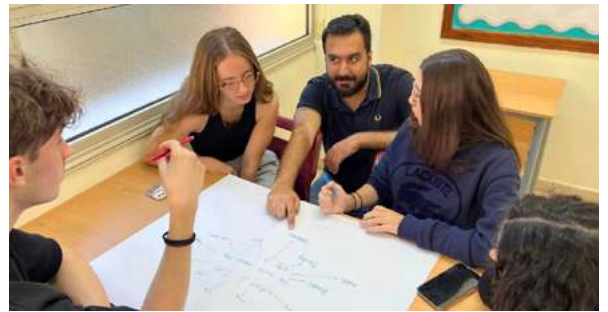
